SAINT OF THE WEEK:

Saint Stanislaus

Stanislaus was born of noble parents near Krakow, Poland. Once he was ordained a priest, he was noted for his preaching and became a much sought after spiritual adviser. Because of his successful reforming efforts, he was named Bishop of Krakow. He incurred the hatred of King Boleslaus the Bold when he denounced the King's cruelties and injustices, especially his kidnapping of the beautiful wife of a nobleman. Stanislaus excommunicated the King and stopped services at the Cathedral when Boleslaus entered. Boleslaus himself killed Stanislaus while the Bishop was saying Mass in a chapel outside the city on April 11. Stanislaus has long been the symbol of Polish nationhood. He is also the patron saint of Krakow and of maintaining moral order. His feast day is April 11th.

UNDERSTANDING OF THE HOLY MASS:

Concluding Rite (Part 1)

The concluding rites include the blessing, dismissal, and recessional hymn. By giving ourselves to Christ at Mass, we are better able to give selflessly to others. The Mass ends when the priest blesses the faith community (reminding it of its mission). Either the priest or deacon, if present, says "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord" or another optional dismissal.
