VIRTUS CERTIFICATION

It is important that all parish volunteers update their VIRTUS certification. Per Paragraph 2.3 Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston: Policy Relating to Sexual Abuse of Children—“Personnel includes all personnel paid and volunteer of the Diocese including: all school personnel, clergy, religious, Directors of Religious Education, catechists, parish staff, child-care agency and program personnel, youth ministry personnel, seminarians, members of school boards, and members of parish and finance councils. Of special concern are paid and volunteer Diocesan personnel in a supervisory capacity, or in particularly high-risk areas—such as those who work with or around children, the very elderly, and the physically and mentally infirm—also those who counsel others, and generally those who work with people who are less capable of protecting themselves.” Please see Fr. Bill after Mass to either update or begin your VIRTUS certification. If you have completed the online or group training, you do not need to do a second round. However, you do need to update your policy statements and background check forms.

SAINT OF THE WEEK:

Saint Boniface

Boniface (681-754) was known as the “Apostle of Germany.” His birth name was “Winfrith,” by Pope Gregory II gave him the name Boniface or “doer of good deeds.” Although he faced countless numbers of hardships, he preached the gospel diligently in the Eighth Century to bring Germany out of paganism. He founded an abbey in Fulda and was the Bishop of Mainz. While waiting to confirm new Christians in the town of Freisland, he and 30 companions were martyred by enemy soldiers. Boniface is the patron saint of brewers. His feast day is June 5.
