VIRTUS CERTIFICATION

Those of you who received emails from Fr. Bill regarding VIRTUS certification/recertification, please see Lynne Bauer in the parish hall immediately after Mass. The certification includes three parts: First, you will complete two forms—the policy statement and the background check. Policy statements must be redone because the State of West Virginia has changed the reporting law of a sexual crime from 48 to 24 hours. Background checks must be done every five (5) years. Lynne will give you the most recent safe environment booklet and a sheet that explains how to sign up for the VIRTUS video (those who have already watched the video or attended the class do not have to repeat this portion of the training).

To report an incidence of suspected child sexual abuse, please contact your local law enforcement agency, or you may confidentially contact WV Child Protective Services at 800.352.6513. To report suspected cases of sexual abuse by personnel of the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston to the Diocese, please contact the Diocese at 888.434.6237 or 304.233.0880.

Saint Justin Martyr

Saint Justin was born in 100 and died a martyr’s death in 165. He converted to the Christian Faith at age 30. In Justin’s two works Dialogues and Apologies, he provides details about his conversion and explains the truths of the Faith. Justin also presents information about how the earliest Christian worship was celebrated. He is the patron saint of philosophers and apologists (teachers and defenders of faith and dogma). His feast day is June 1.
