### VIRTUS CERTIFICATION

It is important that all parish volunteers update their VIRTUS certification. Per Paragraph 2.3 Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston: Policy Relating to Sexual Abuse of Children—"Personnel includes all personnel paid and volunteer of the Diocese including: all school personnel, clergy, religious, Directors of Religious Education, catechists, parish staff, child-care agency and program personnel, youth ministry personnel, seminarians, members of school boards, and members of parish and finance councils. Of special concern are paid and volunteer Diocesan personnel in a supervisory capacity, or in particularly high-risk areas—such as those who work with or around children, the very elderly, and the physically and mentally infirm—also those who counsel others, and generally those who work with people who are less capable of protecting themselves." Please see Fr. Bill after Mass to either update or begin your VIRTUS certification. If you have completed the online or group training, you do not need to do a second round. However, you do need to update your policy statements and background check forms.

### SAINT OF THE WEEK: Saint Anthony of Padua

Saint Anthony, born into a wealthy family in Portugal, changed his name from Fernando when he joined the new Franciscan Order. His voyage was blown off-course to Italy where he stayed. A departing Franciscan novice stole Anthony's valuable book of psalms that contained notes and comments to help him preach and teach. When Anthony discovered it was missing, he prayed it would be found or returned to him. The thief returned the book and, in an extra step, returned to the Order as well. So simple and resounding was his teaching of the Catholic Faith that the most unlettered and the innocent could understand his messages. It is for this reason he was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius XII in 1946. He was only 35-years-old when he died and was canonized less than one year afterward by Pope Gregory IX. Upon exhumation some 336 years after his death, his body was corrupted, yet his tongue was totally incorrupt, so perfect were the teachings that had been formed upon it. Anthony is venerated all over the world as the Patron Saint for lost articles, and is credited with many miracles involving lost people, lost things and even lost spiritual goods. His feast day is June 13.
