#### **VIRTUS CERTIFICATION**

Those of you who received emails from Fr. Bill regarding VIRTUS certification/recertification, please see Lynne Bauer in the parish hall immediately after Mass. The certification includes three parts: First, you will complete two forms—the policy statement and the background check. Policy statements must be redone because the State of West Virginia has changed the reporting law of a sexual crime from 48 to 24 hours. Background checks must be done every five (5) years. Lynne will give you the most recent safe environment booklet and a sheet that explains how to sign up for the VIRTUS video (those who have already watched the video or attended the class do not have to repeat this portion of the training).

### **SAINT OF THE WEEK:**

*Saint Rita of Cascia*

Rita was born in a small Italian town in 1381. From an early age she desired to become a nun. However, her elderly parents insisted that she be married at the age of twelve to a man described in accounts of her life as cruel and harsh. She spent eighteen extremely unhappy years, had two sons, and was finally widowed when her husband was killed in a brawl. Rita urged forgiveness in contrast to the customary vendetta of her day. When both sons also died, she tried unsuccessfully to enter the Augustinians in their convent at Cascia. She was refused because she was a widow and because of the requirement that all sisters should be virgins. Finally, the order gave her entry, and she earned fame for her 40 years of austerity, devotion to prayer, and charity. Toward the end of her life, she received wounds on her forehead which resembled Jesus’ crown of thorns. Just after she died, many miracles were reported instantly. Rita is honored as a patron saint of hopeless causes. Her feast day is May 22.
