SAINT OF THE WEEK:

SAINT MATTHIAS

Matthias, whose feast day is May 14, is the replacement apostle for Judas Iscariot. Although there is no mention of Matthias in the synoptic gospels (Matthew, Mark, and Luke), the Acts of the Apostles states that Matthias had been a disciple since Jesus’ baptism in the Jordan until his ascension. Peter suggested that the 120 disciples select a new apostle to replace Judas. They cast lots between two men: Joseph called Barsabas and Matthias. The lot fell to Matthias.

VIRTUS CERTIFICATION

Those of you who received emails from Fr. Bill regarding VIRTUS certification/recertification, please see Lynne Bauer in the parish hall immediately after Mass. The certification includes three parts: First, you will complete two forms—the policy statement and the background check. Policy statements must be redone because the State of West Virginia has changed the reporting law of a sexual crime from 48 to 24 hours. Background checks must be done every five (5) years. Lynne will give you the most recent safe environment booklet and a sheet that explains how to sign up for the VIRTUS video (those who have already watched the video or attended the class do not have to repeat this portion of the training).
