Per Paragraph 2.3 Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston: Policy Relating to Sexual Abuse of Children—"Personnel includes all personnel paid and volunteer of the Diocese including: all school personnel, clergy, religious, Directors of Religious Education, catechists, parish staff, child-care agency and program personnel, youth ministry personnel, seminarians, members of school boards, and members of parish and finance councils. Of special concern are paid and volunteer Diocesan personnel in a supervisory capacity, or in particularly high-risk areas—such as those who work with or around children, the very elderly, and the physically and mentally infirm—also those who counsel others, and generally those who work with people who are less capable of protecting themselves." Please see Fr. Bill after Mass to either update or begin your VIRTUS certification. If you have completed the online or group training, you do not need to do a second round. However, you do need to update your policy statements and background check forms.
